OUR DRIVING QUESTION:

How can we, as Historians, demonstrate how the Romans changed the world forever?

AS WRITERS we will develop our knowledge of the Roman Army, including writing a letter from a Roman Soldier. We will continue to develop our knowledge of fronted adverbials and expanded noun phrases.

AS COMPUTER SCIENTISTS we will be learning how we can use computers to research and develop a topic.

AS CITIZENS (PSHCE/RE) we will explore Dreams and Goal Setting through PSHCE. In RE, we will be comparing Churches and denominations within the Christian faith.

AS MUSICIANS we will be continuing the work we started last half-term, learning to play the ukulele.

AS SCIENTISTS we will be investigating sound and how it travels. We will be learning about how music instruments make their different sounds and also how to make an area soundproof.

AS MATHEMATICIANS we will be looking at Roman Numerals before moving onto fractions.

AS ARTISTS we will be looking at Roman mosaics before looking at monuments. We will then use this knowledge to create models of Roman temples.

IN FRENCH we will continue to name body parts, introduce the family as well as exploring the alphabet.

AS HISTORIANS we will be taking an in-depth look at how the Romans shaped the world by answering our driving question.

AS ATHLETES we are introducing netball: learning how to pass and move; attack and defend as well as the basic rules of the game.
