


# Villages, Towns and Cities Knowledge Organiser - Year 3 Autumn 1

Keywords	
<b>Population</b>	The number of people in a particular place.
<b>Distribution</b>	How something is spread out.
<b>Population density</b>	The number of people per square kilometre..
<b>Settlement</b>	An area where humans live
<b>Village</b>	A small settlement that can have between 100 and approximately 3,000 people.
<b>Town</b>	A mid-sized settlement that can have between 1,000 and 100,000 people.
<b>City</b>	A city is a large settlement that usually has more than 100,000 people.
<b>Megacity</b>	A city with at least 10 million people. 1950 - two megacities (New York and Tokyo) 2010 - 23 megacities 2019 - 33 megacities
<b>Employment</b>	A job
<b>Leisure</b>	Activities that people do in their spare time when they are not working.
<b>Advantage</b>	A positive, good thing about something
<b>Disadvantage</b>	A negative, bad thing about something
<b>Hunter-gatherer</b>	Someone who hunts and collects their food from the wild.
<b>Nomadic people</b>	People who move around from place to place.
<b>Land use</b>	The purpose or use that an area has.



Land Use in Cities	
<b>Residential</b>	Housing of all types
<b>Commercial</b>	Businesses, offices and shops
<b>Industrial</b>	Factories, warehouses (large buildings for storage), rubbish and recycling facilities
<b>Planned Development</b>	Future plans for new buildings, shopping centres and education centres
<b>Transportation</b>	Roads, bus ways, cycling paths, railway lines
<b>Parks and Open Space</b>	Big parks

## The Differences Between Villages, Towns and Cities

<b>Village</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- In the countryside</li> <li>- Some services such as a post office, a small shop and sometimes a small place of worship</li> <li>- There may be a doctors practice and a primary school</li> <li>- Many people are leaving villages to move to towns and cities.</li> </ul>
<b>Town</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Services such as primary and secondary schools, train stations, hospitals and shopping centres</li> <li>- Large supermarkets and at least one place of worship</li> </ul>
<b>City</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Many different types of services, including universities, sports stadiums and a large variety of shops</li> <li>- Many restaurants, transport links and different places of worship</li> <li>- Many people move to cities because there are more opportunities for employment and leisure.</li> </ul>
