OUR DRIVING QUESTION:

What factors affect where people live?

AS WRITERS we are reading the book 'Varjak Paw', the exciting tale of a cat who must learn new skills in order to survive in the outside world. We will be writing in role and creating our own new chapter for this fabulous text.

AS MATHEMATICIANS we are building a strong base for our learning. We'll be reviewing place value and working on Addition and Subtraction, and using Bar Models to show problems.

AS GEOGRAPHERS we will be learning about types of settlement and the differences between them.

AS COMPUTER SCIENTISTS we will be exploring what we need to be safe online and getting used to our learning platforms.

AS ATHLETES, we will be predominantly concentrating on Strength and Fitness Training incorporating Athletics. This will take place out on the school field when the weather is kind!

AS SCIENTISTS we will be exploring the changing world in terms of plants and their life cycles.

AS CITIZENS (PSHCE/RE) we are exploring Health and Wellbeing and how recent events might affect this, and learning about some key beliefs of Judaism.
