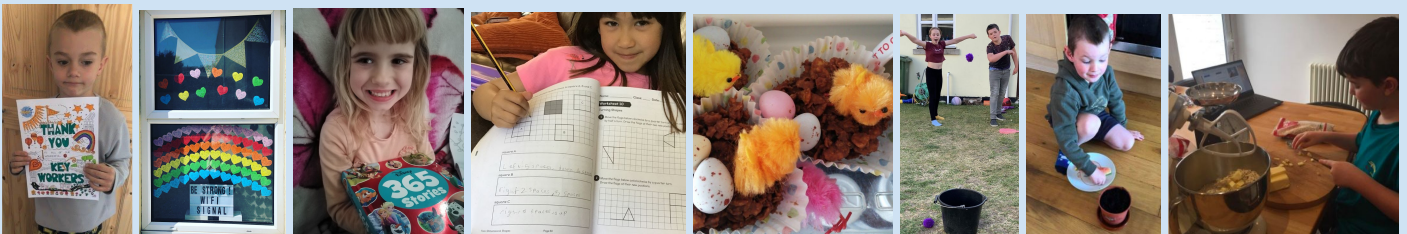

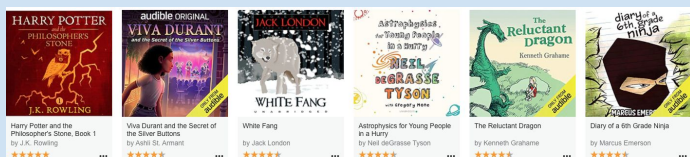

We've loved sharing what everyone has been up to at home on our Atlantic Facebook/[Twitter](#) pages. Here are some of our highlights from this week!

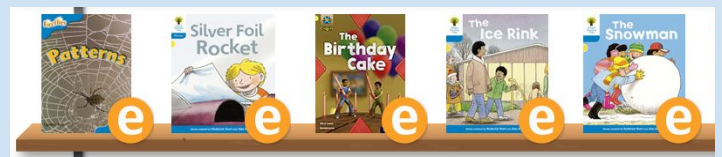
