OUR DRIVING QUESTION:

AS WRITERS we will be exploring the book Goldfish Boy by Lisa Thompson and using this to write in a variety of genres. The Greatest Showman will give us inspiration for an extended piece of narrative writing.

AS COMPUTER SCIENTISTS we will be looking at what makes a good website before embarking on our own website creation.

AS CITIZENS we will be finding out about the role of children in society; prayer and why we celebrate Easter as a festival.

AS ARTISTS we will be using pencil sketches to create self portraits. We will progress to an artist study on Pablo Picasso to create abstract sculptures.

What influence can geographers have on urban policy?

AS MATHEMATICIANS we will be applying our knowledge of the four operations in algebra and with negative numbers. We will also develop our data handling and analysis skills through line graphs and pie charts.
