Re: Swimming Year 6

As part of the curriculum it is a requirement that children are able to swim 25 metres unaided, by the end of Year 6. Your child was assessed back in Year 5 and it is noted they still need to achieve this.

We have the opportunity to facilitate this at Osprey Leisure Centre, Portland, **starting on Thursday 10th June 2021.**

The children will travel to Osprey Leisure Centre by minibus, leaving after lunch and returning by the end of the Academy day. If you would like to collect your child from Osprey Quay at 2.45pm, or let them walk home please indicate this on the consent form. Also, if your child is entitled to FSM and would like a packed lunch provided, please complete the form. Children will be accompanied and supervised by adults at all times.

Once at the Leisure Centre, the children will be taught by a qualified swimming coach and the pool will be supervised by lifeguards. Those children who still need to achieve their 25 metres will do this over the following 3 weeks.

Please provide your child with a swimming costume or trunks and a towel in a small rucksack or suitable bag.
