# Secondary Parent Forum Meeting 19th October 2021

### **Progress Reports:**

**You said:** The reports were missing the personal input and it is difficult to see if your child is 'doing well' generally.

**We said:** The attitude to learning scores give a general overview and impression of how well students are doing at school, not taking into account academic success.

**You said:** The numbers for attitude to learning scores are unclear.

**We said:** We will look into using statements: Excellent, Good, Inconsistent and Poor instead of the numbers which will make the attitude to learning more clear.

**You said:** Some parents did not like the 'Year Group Average' for the Knowledge Organiser Scores as it can be demoralising.

**We said:** The 'Year Group Average' allowed for comparison, for example if a student got 38 and the year group average was 35 is very different to if a student got 38 and the year group average was 81. This gives students and parents some idea of the key knowledge that may need revisiting.

You said: You would like more recognition for student progress and improvement.

**We said:** We have a focus on students who make progress and those that make the most progress from Unit to Unit receive a Principals Commendations Certificate and 50 Positive Points. We will look into a way of recording progress/improvement on Student Progress Reports and also recognising those students who make improvements on their Attitude to Learning.

### **Uniform & equipment:**

You said: Sourcing uniform is still a problem.

### **Behaviour:**

**You said:** The behaviour tariff was quite clear and sanctions were clearly in place to support any poor behaviour. It was suggested that a myth buster information document was sent out to parents/carers regarding the AR & ABE rooms.
