This is a great opportunity to get out on the water, following the completion of SATs

Please drop your child at the Sailing Academy for 9.15am and collect from there at 2.30pm.

Students should wear PE Kit. In a rucksack they will need to bring their swimming costume/trunks, water shoes or old trainers that can get wet, towel and a warm jumper for when they come out of the water (even if it is a hot day), sun cream and hat if the weather is hot. Please provide your child with a packed lunch and plenty to drink. If your child is entitled to FSM and you would like us to provide a packed lunch, please indicate this on the consent form.

We will have a 'wet weather' plan in place should the weather not be good enough for an afternoon at the beach.

Wetsuits and buoyancy aids will be provided.

The cost of the trip is £5 and should be paid via sQuid.
