Homework in Y6

Year 6 is an important time in your child's journey through school: it marks the end of their primary phase and the start of their transition into secondary. To ensure that your child achieves the best that they can, we are making the following amendments to their homework.

As a reminder, the current homework expectations for KS2 at Atlantic Academy are:

- 20 minutes of reading every day;
- Maths Questions set Monday due the following Monday;
- Spelling Words set Friday due the following Friday;
- Activity challenges linked to your child's current topic.

Your child will now be given a maths and spelling based booklet to complete each week. It will be **issued on the day as stated above** and **due in the following week**. These books will need to be returned to school each week on their hand in day for marking and will form part of the weekly lesson. Should a book be misplaced, then a charge will be levied to obtain a replacement.

In addition to this, over half term your child will be given a personalised maths booklet to support them in areas identified in their recent PPEs which they need extra practice with at home. To support work at home, help sheets have been provided on Google Classroom.

Currently children can access a homework club during their break, this will be extended to a dedicated quiet time during Wednesday break where they can complete their booklets with the support of an adult.
