

Curriculum

Our curriculum vision is to deliver an authentic education for the 21st century for children from the age of Reception - Year 11. The aim of the curriculum is to ensure all students are inspired with a passion for learning and achieve high levels of academic success in a broad range of subjects whilst at the same time equipping them with the knowledge and skills required to play an active and successful role in today's highly competitive and fast-changing world.

Our Curriculum:

- Ensures a broad curriculum coverage
- Develops a knowledge rich curriculum
- Ensures that knowledge acquisition is enhanced through being effectively applied to real-life situations and problems
- Widens knowledge acquisition through single discipline and transdisciplinary learning
- Ensures all learning is challenging and engaging

- Promotes teacher planning that is integral to the success and progression of the curriculum and also manageable.

Atlantic Academy, like any Aspirations Academy, shares a common philosophy but has a distinctive approach to education. There are 3 guiding principles and 8 conditions that all Aspirations Academies adhere to. These principles are central to the curriculum:

Facilities

At Atlantic we provide as broad a spectrum of opportunities as possible for students to explore and discover a love of learning. We have excellent educational facilities onsite to support these ambitions.

Technology is at the forefront of our curriculum and to support this we have a range of devices from Chromebooks to iPads in every classroom to enhance our curriculum provision. We also boast a state of the art 'Creator Space', decked with 3D printers, robotics and Virtual Reality headsets so that our students can explore.

Our five Science laboratories with sea views over the Atlantic, are housed within a dedicated Science wing. The department has a well stocked preparation room and a study area which allows for great flexibility in terms of use of time, with the transition between practical and theoretical activity able to be made very quickly.

We have extensive resources to support students to access their design and technology curriculum including a spacious, fully equipped kitchen. The design and technology workshops have a range of fixed machinery inclusive of pillar drills, lathes and a brazing hearth.

Finally our light and airy art studio and exhibition space boast enviable views across Portland Bill creating the inspiration any budding artist would wish for.







Sports Facilities

Atlantic Academy is housed on an enviable 17.5 acres of land with surrounding sea views reaching far beyond the playing fields.

On site we have a large six-court sports hall as well as a purpose built dance studio. The Academy supports a community Gym which is housed in the grounds of Atlantic Academy and provides modern equipment for both students and members of our community to use.

Our large grass field is perfect for football, rugby and hockey and we host a number of Summer events for the community to attend. Our netball and basket ball courts are nestled in our grounds and are used through the year to compete in inter school competitions.

We have strong links with sporting activities in the local community. Children can access sailing courses, mounting biking and explore the many trails on the island and try rock climbing in the local area.

Our Reception students will be participating in weekly Beach School visits to help promote their love and understanding of the historical Jurassic Coast we live in.

Beach School

Weekly beach sessions for students at Atlantic are timetabled into the school week.

Elements of Beach School are sewn into the curriculum for practical science, geography, maths and English. The work of the students feed into projects run by academy research bodies including the British naturalists' Association, the Marine Biological Association and also local university studies. Children work with local expert groups and twinning with other Beach Schools to share learning.

Beach School aims to demonstrate the importance of Portland's unique and historical coastline to the students and also instil in them an understanding of their impact on the environment.

ATL Curriculum

The curriculum developed at Atlantic Academy aims to reflect our local community and the particular needs of our students.

This curriculum outline reflects the knowledge and skills, and the local social and employment context, that pupils need in order to take advantage of opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of later life. Our curriculum will help to powerfully address social disadvantage.
