## **OUR DRIVING QUESTION:**

**IN WRITING** The children will **IN MATHEMATICS** Pupils will be revisiting counting skills and developing an understanding in finding 1 more/less than a given number. They will use their number skills to recognise when groups of objects have the more/fewer/equal amounts. The children will begin to double numbers and look at the composition of numbers 6 and 7.

IN PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT we will be discovering everything fun about Bats and Rackets! Beginning to learn the fundamentals of tennis passing, batting and fielding.

## IN UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

The children will be learning about space and the solar system. They will research famous astronauts from the past and learn what life would be like in space. We will also look at nocturnal and diurnal animals.

## IN PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

We will be thinking about the perspective of others and learning how to be more resilient and persevere when facing a challenge.

**IN PHONICS** This half term we shall continue to recap our Set 1 sounds and digraphs. We will also begin to look at our Set 2 sounds.

IN EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN The children will be creating a night sky inspired by Vincent Van Gogh and illustrations by Eric Carle. We will focus on collaging and printing skills.
