On **Thursday 21st November** the children will be travelling by coach to Dorchester to visit the Dorset Museum. During our visit we will take part in a workshop on the Stone, Bronze and Iron Ages. If the weather permits, after lunch, we will then travel to The Iron Age Roundhouse at The Prince of Wales School and the largest hillfort in Europe, Maiden Castle.

Due to the trip falling on a Thursday, PE will take place on the Friday of the same week.

The children should wear their Atlantic Academy PE kit, but please ensure that your child has suitable footwear and a warm waterproof coat should we be able to visit The Prince of Wales School and Maiden Castle.
