OUR DRIVING QUESTION

How can we as historians understand what life was like for the Mayans?

AS WRITERS we take inspiration from our class text 'Oh Maya Gods' by Maz Evans to create setting descriptions based on Mayan Temples, poetry describing the vibrant rainforests and persuasive writing.

AS HISTORIANS we will be looking at how the Mayans lived, what they believed in, how they were ruled and what their achievements were. We will use our knowledge to curate a museum of Mayan art and artifacts.

AS MATHEMATICIANS we will be working on multiplication and division followed by fractions.

AS CITIZENS (PSHCE/RE) we will be studying Christianity. In PSHE we will be thinking about our feelings and those of others, whilst maintaining respectful friendships.

AS ARTISTS we will be looking at the ancient Mayan weaving techniques and creating our own textile art.

AS SCIENTISTS we are going to be studying the Earth and the Solar system. We will be looking at the different scientists who investigated what the Earth and planets looked like in the past and the types of evidence they used.

AS COMPUTER SCIENTISTS we will be improving our programming and coding skills.

AS ATHLETES we will be delving into the world of Gymnastics, mastering floor movements and shapes as well as using the apparatus in the Sports Hall.
