Dear Parents and Carers,

We would like to inform you about some updates to our behaviour strategy, which will come into effect from Monday, 27th January. Before outlining these changes, we want to express how proud we are of the behaviour and attitudes of our students. The vast majority consistently meet or exceed the high expectations we set for them. These updates are designed to address behaviours of a small minority of students who occasionally disrupt the learning environment.

Key Updates:

1. Punctuality

Students arriving late to school, after the gate has closed, will receive a 30-minute detention during breaktime. If they require food from the dining room, they will be escorted to collect it.

2. Supervision (formerly ABE)

- Students placed in supervision will need to hand in their mobile phones at the start of the school day. These will be returned at the end of the day.
- Supervision will now extend until 3:30 pm, at which point phones will also be returned.

3. Truancy

- Students found truanting will be placed in supervision for the remainder of the day until 3:30 pm.
- If a student is truanting during lesson 5, they will remain in supervision until breaktime the following school day.

We believe these measures are essential to maintaining a positive learning environment where all students can thrive. Regular attendance and active participation in lessons are crucial for achieving their full potential.

To coincide with these changes we are excited to be launching our new rewards strategy and information will be shared with you early next week.
