Dear Parents/Carers

It's been a lovely start to the Spring term and it's been great to see everyone back after the Christmas break ready to learn and engaged in lessons!

Unfortunately, It has come to our attention both from monitoring and through pupil voice that a small minority of students have been regularly abusing the privilege of using the toilets during lesson time, causing disruptions to both their own learning and that of others.

While we recognise the importance of students having access to toilets when needed, it is equally important to ensure that lessons are not interrupted unnecessarily. Unfortunately, this misuse of toilet privileges is affecting the flow of instruction, and we are committed to maintaining a focused and productive learning environment for all our students.

As a result, we will be monitoring toilet usage during lesson times and encouraging students to use the toilets during appropriate times, such as break and lunch periods. If there are individuals who continue to abuse the privilege of using the toilets during lesson time, we may need to take further steps, including limiting or temporarily restricting individual students' access to toilets during lessons, in order to minimise disruptions.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we work together to ensure that our school remains a place of effective learning for all students.
