- Encourage your child to embrace all opportunities: enrichment, trips, leadership opportunities

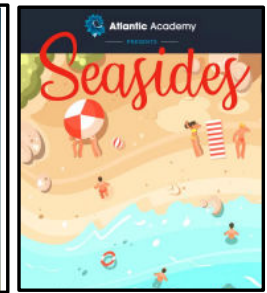
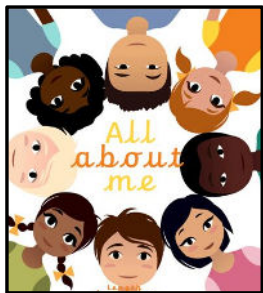

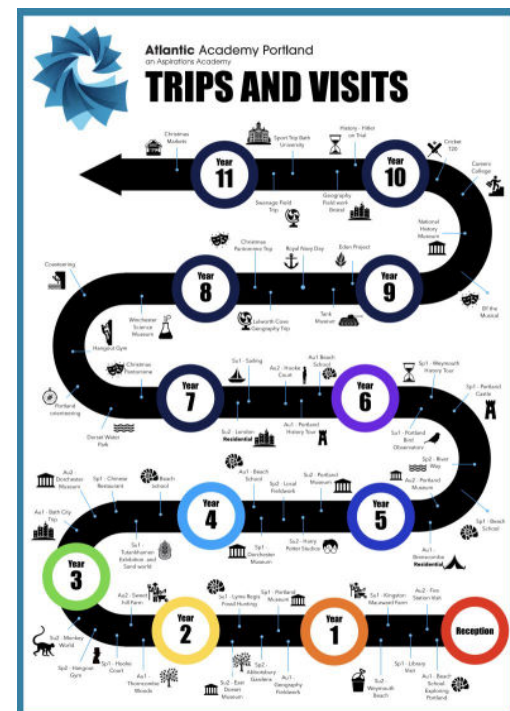
