RE: Year 9 Remote Work Experience Event

We are pleased to inform you that your child will be taking part in a Year 9 remote work experience event from Monday 24th to Wednesday 26th November, during Periods 1 to 4 each day.

As part of our ongoing partnership with 'Futures for All' and a range of employers, students will take part in a choice of two out of 15 employer-led experiences in November and February. Each experience introduces students to a different employment sector and provides insight into the world of work.

During the November event, students will work online in teams on a project brief provided by an employer. Each employer will introduce a range of job roles within their industry and guide students through a set of real-world tasks that reflect how teams collaborate in professional settings.

The February experience will follow the same format but focus on different employment sectors, giving students a chance to broaden their understanding of the world of work.

Through these experiences, students will develop essential power skills such as collaboration, communication, critical thinking, character and creativity. The programme also aims to raise career awareness, build confidence and motivation, and connect learning in the academy to real-life workplaces.

Students will be able to choose from seven industry sectors for the November experience. This will make their selections during allocated tutor time sessions next week. More information can be found in this [slideshow](#).
