Supporting your child's progress in Year 6

As your child progresses through Year 6 and prepares for the end of Key Stage 2, we would like to share some simple and effective ways you can support their learning at home.

Regular, short bursts of practice can make a significant difference to your child's confidence and attainment. We recommend encouraging your child to spend just 10–15 minutes each day revisiting key skills.

For maths, your child can use Times Table Rock Stars and NumBots. Spending just five minutes on each daily can help to build rapid recall of times tables, strengthen mental maths skills, and develop efficient strategies for addition and subtraction.

To support reading, spelling and grammar, we recommend regular use of Lexia. This platform reinforces key skills such as spelling patterns, punctuation, and reading comprehension in an engaging and structured way.

In addition, your child has access to a range of resources via Google Classroom. Within this, you will find materials under ‘GPS Help’, ‘Maths Help’, and ‘Mock Revision Tasks’, all of which are designed to consolidate classroom learning and provide further practice across the curriculum.
