Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 3 Sleepover Friday 1st May 2026

We are excited to confirm that we are holding our Year 3 Sleepover on Friday 1st May 2026. Attendance at the sleepover is dependent on behaviour within school, and should there be a decision for your child not to be allowed to take part this will be decided by the class teacher and you will be informed of this.

On the Friday all Year 3 students can come to school in their PE kit as we spend the morning using our map reading skills and compasses to walk to Portland Bill Channel Watch Station. Please ensure your child has suitable footwear and clothing appropriate for the weather e.g sunhat/ cream/ raincoat. On our return to school, children will have lunch as normal and spectate at the May Fair. Children attending the sleepover will remain on site for the evening where they will take part in activities such as; watching a film 'The Iron Giant', outdoor games (weather permitting) and stories with hot chocolate.

We have arranged for Codfathers to deliver food, sausage or chicken nuggets with chips. Please indicate on the form the food choice that your child would like, we will also arrange for snacks and drinks during the evening and breakfast on Saturday morning

Please ensure that your child brings the following to school on Friday morning ready for the sleepover;

- Sleeping Bag
- Pillow
- Pjs
- Washbag (containing toothbrush and toothpaste)
- Change of clothes
- Warm clothes

We would ask that no mobile phones or devices are brought into school for the sleepover.

Students will be sleeping in two separate areas of the school, split into boys & girls and will be supervised by members of staff at all times.

Please collect your child from the Primary gate at **8am on Saturday morning**.

In order to cover the costs of the refreshments we ask that you pay **£13 via your parentMail** account by the deadline of **Monday 27th April at 12pm**.
