Year 7 Visit to Salisbury Cathedral

On Friday 17th April, Year 7 have the exciting opportunity to visit Salisbury Cathedral

This trip will give students the opportunity to explore the magnificent medieval building of Salisbury Cathedral, home to Britain's tallest spire. During the visit, students will learn more about life in medieval England and the power of medieval monarchs, linking directly to their current History studies. Students will explore the Cathedral Close and Cloisters, see the world's oldest mechanical clock, and view one of the best-preserved original copies of the 1215 Magna Carta, an important document that limited the power of the king. As part of the visit, students will also take part in a hands-on workshop designed to deepen their understanding of medieval society, kingship, and the significance of Magna Carta in shaping the relationship between monarchs and their subjects.

Students should wear uniform and a suitable coat for the trip. Please provide your child with a packed lunch for the visit. If your child is entitled to FSM and you would like us to provide a packed lunch please indicate this on the consent form.

The cost of the trip is £23.75, this is now open on ParentMail for payment.
