Re: Weymouth Junior Citizen Event, Monday 15th June 2026

On Monday 15th June, Year 6 have been invited to Weymouth's Junior Citizen Event. Junior Citizen is a multi-agency safety initiative aimed at 10- to 11-year-olds and is specifically designed to provide them with life skills that will, in the future, help keep themselves and others safe. The aim of the Junior Citizen team is to raise a child's awareness of threats and dangers, in a fun and interactive way, with all participating Emergency Service and partner agencies ensuring that their presentations reflect current trends and dangers/risks to children.

We will travel to Weymouth Football Club by coach, leaving school just after 9am. We will return to school in time for lunch. Students will be accompanied by academy staff throughout the visit.

The cost of the trip will be **£8** per child, this should be paid via your ParentMail account. This is under 50% of the cost of the event, with the remaining money being sponsored by Network Rail.

As with all trips we reserve the right to withdraw a student from the trip on the grounds of their behaviour and conduct in the time leading up to the trip.
