**RE: Y6 Bournemouth University Trip -Thursday 25th June 2026.**

Year 6 have been invited to an exciting day at Bournemouth University on Thursday 25th June. Students will return to school at approximately 3:30pm.

This experience links closely to our Year 6 focus on transition to secondary school and thinking ahead to future pathways. It is designed to broaden pupils' understanding of the wide range of careers and opportunities available to them, helping to open their eyes to what lies beyond primary school. During the day, pupils will take part in a 'university adventure', where they will explore different career paths, engage in hands-on activities, and take part in an interactive campus tour. By the end of the visit, the aim is for pupils to have a greater awareness of their future possibilities, feel inspired to raise their aspirations, and begin to see higher education as a realistic and exciting option for themselves.

**This trip has been funded by Bournemouth University so there will be no charge to participate, however, we do require you to complete the [following form](#). The deadline for this is Friday 19th June 12pm.**

Bournemouth University's work with schools is funded by the Government and aims to increase the number of young people from different backgrounds going into university. Using the Higher Education Access Tracker Service (HEAT), a national service used by over 80 universities, they are able to track students' progression from school into university. This in turn helps them to show the effect of their activities so they can continue to offer free activities to schools. If you don't want your data to be used for the purposes described in this notice, you don't have to complete the form. Your child will still be able to take part in the activities we are offering.
